Recipe

Bacon Mac and Cheese -

The Ultimate Comfort Food

1 Cup Macaroni noodles

4 TBLS Unsalted Butter (do not substitute)

4 TBLS All purpose flour

11/2 Cup Milk

1½ Cup Grated Cheddar Cheese3 Strips Cooked bacon (chopped)

Salt and pepper to taste

Chopped Green onion (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Cook noodles until al dente. Drain and set aside.
- Melt butter in a pan; over medium heat add in flour. Stir constantly until flour dissolved.
- 3. Slowly pour in ³/₄ Cup of the milk. Whisk until thick and creamy. Pour in another half of milk and whisk continuously until creamy. Turn off heat
- Now add the cheese, bacon, salt and pepper. Whisk until smooth and well incorporated.
- Serve in a bowl with optional chopped onions on top and enjoy!
