through the Salvation Army or Love In Action.*

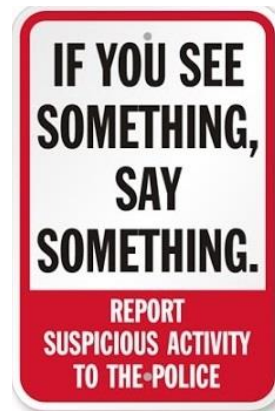
