### **WHY POTHOLES?**



When roads that have been frozen all winter begin to thaw from the surface downward, melting snow and ice saturate the softened ground. During the spring thaw, the roadbed softened by trapped moisture beneath the pavement makes it more susceptible to damage. This Lance Wyhowski also contributes to pothole problems already occurring due to this winter's numerous freeze-thaw cycles.

### Easy tips on what to check:

- ✓ If the outdoor temp is above 60°F, you are safe to turn on your air
- ✓ Make sure there's no debris around your A/C unit
- ✓ Check your furnace filter and replace if clogged
- ✓ Make sure the outside condenser is not plugged
- ✓ Check your circuit breaker and make sure it's in the ON position
- ✓ Open all supply registers and check airflow to make sure it's cold
- ✓ Make sure your thermostat batteries are good
