AIR CONDTIONER SPRING CHECK

From Capitol Supply and Service If you switched from winter boots to flip flips, it's time to check your air conditioning system

Easy tips on what to check:

- ✓ If the outdoor temp is above 60° F, you are safe to turn on your air
- \checkmark Make sure there's no debris around your A/C unit
- ✓ Check your furnace filter and replace if clogged (annually)
- \checkmark Make sure the outside condenser is not plugged
- ✓ Check your circuit breaker and make sure it's in the ON position
- \checkmark Open all supply registers and check airflow to make sure it's cold
- ✓ Make sure your thermostat batteries are good
