YUMMY! **HULL-LESS CARMEL CORN**

- 11 oz. – Jay's O-Ke-Doke Corn Puffs
- 2 cups packed Brown Sugar
- ½ cup Karo Syrup
- 1 cup Butter (Not Margarine)
- 1 tsp Baking Soda

In a large bowl mix sugar, syrup and butter. Microwave until boiling. When reached boiling remove from microwave and add baking soda.

With Corn puffs in roasting pan, drizzle mixture over all. Stir until mixed.

Bake in 250 degree oven for 1 hour – stir every 10-15 minutes. Place on parchment paper and break apart. Let cool and ENJOY!
