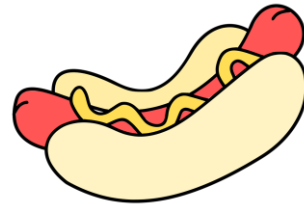
Community Reminders:



- Please spray cracks in sidewalk and driveways with weed killer. If the weeds get too big they will crack the cement.
- If you cut down any limbs or have branches please bring them to your curb and our maintenance staff will pick them up. Please don't throw them in the tree line behind your home.
- Cars parked in visitor parking can stay for a short visit to visit friends and family in the park. If you are a tenant and need to park in visitor parking because your driveway is full please stop by the office to get a sticker for your window so we know that you are a tenant at Village Green. We are posting Katie Bolthouse signs in visitor parking that will state we will tow if unauthorized vehicles are parked there.

It's Hot outside



Save Money on your Air Conditioning

- ❖ Before the thermostat is turned to cooling mode, make sure the system is powered up for at least eight hours to protect the compressor.
- ❖ Make sure the area around the unit is free of debris
- ❖ Replace filters every three months. Clean filters reduce fan pressure, requiring less energy
- ❖ Leave the thermostat's fan switch on "auto", so the fan runs only when the compressor runs
- ❖ Use a programmable thermostat set seven to 10 degrees higher during off-hours to save about 10 percent in cooling costs a year.
- ❖ Draw shades to minimize the amount of hot sunlight entering the room.
- ❖ Use zone thermostats to shut off ducts to areas that aren't being used
- ❖ Use efficient lighting systems that don't emit excessive heat.
- ❖ Ceiling fans can reduce the need for AC, resulting in a potential 15 percent savings.
