We received a letter from the Grand Haven Public Safety stating the following information:

Telemarketing / On-line Fraud

When you send money to people you do not know personally or give personal or financial information to unknown callers, you increase your chances of becoming a victim of telemarketing fraud.

Here are some common fraud schemes:

- Ask you to pay for things by going to the store and buying gift cards
- Romance scam: Criminals pose as interested romantic partners on social media or dating websites to capitalize on their elderly victims desire to find companions.
- Tech support scam: criminals pose as technology support representatives and offer to fix nonexistent computer issues. Then the scammer has access to victims' devices and sensitive information
- Grandparent scam: criminals pose as relative usually a child or grandchild - claiming to be in immediate financial need
- Government impersonation scam: criminals pose as government employees and threaten to arrest or prosecute victims unless they agree to provide funds or payments
- Sweepstakes/charity/lottery scam: criminals claim to work for legitimate charitable organizations to gain victims trust. Or they claim their targets have won a foreign lottery which they can collect for a "fee".

Here is what the caller may tell you:

- You've won a "free gift, vacation, or prize. But you have to pay for "postage and handling" or other charges
- You must send money, give cc, gift card or bank acct numbers, or have a check picked up by courier.
- You don't need to check out the company with anyone.
 The callers say you don't need to speak to any including family, lawyer, BBB, or consumer protection agency.
- You can't afford to miss this "high-profit, no-risk_ offer
- You must ACT 'now' or the offer won't be good

Please take precautions to protect your identity if a criminal gains access to your device or account. Immediately contact your financial institution to place protections on your accounts, and monitor your accounts and personal information for suspicious activity.
